*The International Lacanian Journal of Psychoanalysis*, a new international Lacanian journal has appeared. It combines articles in English, some written by English speakers, and some translated. It is a most exciting journal! The first issue came out in May of 2009, edited by Sophie Marret-Maleval. Publishing Director is Pierre-Gilles Gueguen who is an analyst in Paris, current President of the New Lacanian School, and a member of the World Association of Psychoanalysis. The Consultant, Jacques-Alain-Miller, is the Director of the Department of Psychoanalysis at The University of Paris VIII (Saint Denis); director of the seven schools in the Freudian Field, and director of the World Association of Psychoanalysis.

The contents of the first number of *Hury Burly* include articles by Denis Noble on “What Perspectives can the Biology of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Open on Sexuality?; François Regnault on “Descartes’ Dualism and the Union of the Mind and the Body”; Alexandre Stevens on “Lacanian Interpretation”; Jacques-Alain Miller on “Semblants and Sinthomes”; Josefina Ayerza on “Cy Twombly”; Eric Laurent on “Interview: Butler and Gender”; and numerous others. The second issue appeared in November of 2009 and includes articles by Anne Lysy-Stevens on “How Analysis Operates”; Dominique Laurent on “Woman”; Marie-Hélène Brousse on “A Stop, An End, or a Denouement?”; Jacques-Alain Miller on “The Warsaw Lecture”; and numerous others. Psychoanalysis—theory and treatment—art, science, cinema, gender—these are just some of the themes taken up by both issues.
